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PROCEDURE MANUAL STUDY GUIDE

The Procedure Manual Study Guide is a tool of the Christian Worker Program. It is a workbook to be used along with the Procedure Manual in the training of Mini-Bible School Directors and #1 Links.

The answers to the questions are found in sequence in the Procedure Manual. Those receiving the training should first read through the entire Procedure Manual in order to get an over-all understanding of the Christian Worker Program. The student should then begin at page one of the study guide and start filling in the blanks, referring to the Procedure Manual for the answers. The answers can be found in general sequence by beginning at page one of the Procedure Manual and continuing on until the study guide is completed.

After the student has finished the study guide, it is suggested that he correct his own work by referring to the answer key found on pages 11 and 12. Any incorrect answers should then be thoroughly reviewed, as a clear understanding of the Procedure Manual is essential for the proper operation of the Christian Worker Program.
